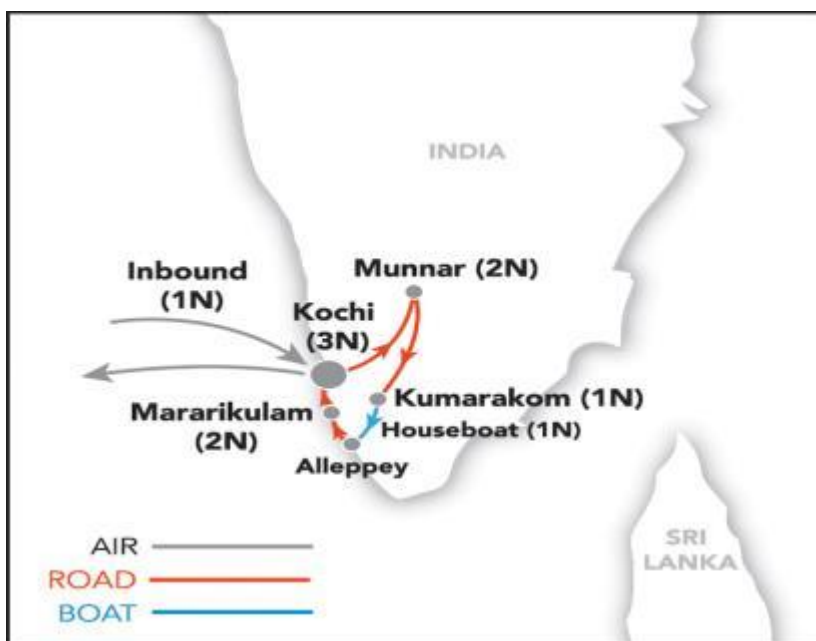

Your Tour Dossier

This document is designed to be read in conjunction with the other pre-departure information provided by Wendy Wu Tours including the tour itinerary as described in our brochure and/or website. It aims to provide a straightforward description of the physical activities involved in sightseeing or travelling during the tour.

If there are any particular challenges, from the length of time spent on your feet, the length of drives and flights, to the standard of remote accommodation; they will be explained here.

All passengers must read this document to ensure the itinerary is suitable for their interests and physical capabilities. This is not your final itinerary and therefore does not mention all the sites visited.



Welcome to Wendy Wu Tours

India continues to amaze, fascinate and thrill our passengers, many of whom have travelled to one country in Asia with us, then another, year after year. We urge you to keep in mind all the rewards, as well as challenges of travelling in a country with a history, culture and attitude so unlike your own.

A typical day's sightseeing may include the bustle and noise of a city street, sights and smells of a local market and interacting with the locals. Travelling in India requires patience as potential delays are to be expected due to standards of service. There is a low level of English spoken throughout India, so your local guides or National Escort will be indispensable during your trip.

Almost everything will be different to what you may be used to. We have found that our passengers who embark with a sense of humour and adventure, who accept that things do not always go to plan, are those who find their experience most rewarding. It is essential that all passengers recognise the demands of factors such as basic facilities and cultural differences they may encounter in some areas.

South India Escape Private Tour - Comfortable Paced Tour

Our private tours are accessible to everyone. This tour will involve sightseeing on foot and some climbing of stairs

This tour is not strenuous, and can be taken at a pace that suits the abilities of passengers travelling in your party. If any member of your party has mobility difficulties, please advise Wendy Wu Tours, so that our operators can be advised and may rearrange the itinerary to suit your needs. If at any point during the tour you feel you are being rushed, or not moving fast enough, please let your local guide know, so that they may adjust the touring accordingly and provide you with the best experience possible.

NB: Please note that times and distances listed in the tour dossier are approximate.

Days 1-2: UK/Kochi

You will be met at the Cochin International Airport in the Arrivals Hall tonight by Local Guide from Wendy Wu Tours. Be Transferred (30 minute drive) to your hotel and check-in.

Day 3: Kochi

Enjoy breakfast at hotel, before easy sightseeing around Kochi including the Dutch Fort, St. Francis Church, Santa Cruz Basilica, Jewish Synagogue, local markets and Chinese fishing nets. Today's sightseeing involves around 2-3 hours on foot and a total of 4-5 hours of sightseeing.

Breakfast and Lunch

Day 4: Kochi to Munnar

Munnar altitude – 1,524m

Drive approximately 3-4 hours (130km) to Munnar – the first hour is a steep and winding descent from the highlands, a stretch of even road and then a steep ascent again to Munnar. The group bus will not be able to drive under the clearance height of the bridge, located just outside Munnar. Hotel staff will send jeeps to collect you and your luggage to take you the remaining short distance to the hotel to check-in.

Breakfast and Lunch

Day 5: Munnar

Travel out to Mattupetty Dam, located around 13km from Munnar town. Enjoy an easy walk around the lakeside areas. Later view Anamudi Peak, which is at an altitude of 2,695m amongst lush green hills.

Depending on the time of year (February-April is Nilgiri Tahr mating season) you may enjoy a walking tour of the national park or light trekking through Munnar this afternoon.

Today's sightseeing involves 7-8 hours on foot (with breaks in between) and walking over uneven terrain. If time permits, you may visit a tea museum (open until 4pm).

Breakfast and Lunch

Day 6: Munnar to Kumarakom

Check-out from the hotel early this morning and drive 1-2 hours (80km) to Kothamangalam town. Here you will enjoy a light walking tour of local rubber, coffee and pepper plantations. Enjoy lunch with local family.

Afterwards, drive 2 hours (76km) to Kumarakom, located in the Kerala backwaters region. Your hotel is located on the banks of the Vembanad Lake and is accessible by coach.

Breakfast and Lunch

Day 7: Kumarakom – Backwater Cruising

After check out from the hotel, enjoy a tour of the Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary by foot. Afterwards, return to the hotel jetty where you will board your overnight houseboat for sightseeing, followed by meals and overnight accommodation. Please note that while on the houseboat, electricity can be intermittent. There is a generator on board, so keep this in mind when charging electronic items. If you are a light sleeper you may wish to bring ear plugs, as the generators may be loud at night.

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 8: Alleppey to Mararikulam

Continue cruising until approximately 9am then disembark at Alleppey. Drive 30-40 minutes (15km) to Mararikulam. Your hotel is located on the beach and is designed with relaxation in mind so there is no individual TV in the guest rooms. A TV is available in the shared recreation room in the hotel. The afternoon is free to enjoy the hotel and beachside facilities.

Day 9: Mararikulam

Tour Kumbalangi Integrated Tourism Village, located on a small island near the Kerala backwaters region. Watch traditional craft demonstrations and enjoy lunch before

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**Before You Leave**

Itinerary Changes - Our intention is to adhere to the day-to-day itinerary as printed; however the order of events and sightseeing may vary according to local conditions or for operational purposes. The schedules of the domestic airlines in India are subject to frequent changes. For this reason, we have indicated approximate times only. Your Local Guides will inform you of any schedule changes as they are informed of them. Roads in India have generally been improved over recent years, but some road construction and/or weather conditions may still lengthen the driving times.

Visas - A visa is required for entry into India. A standard visa processing service is included in your tour cost. You will need to complete the visa application form online at: <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/>. Once completed you will need to print the completed form, and send it to our office along with your passport and 2 photos per person. The photos should be 2 x 2 in size taken within the last 6 months, in order for our office to process your visa with the embassy. We will require all this information 8 weeks prior to departure. As per our standard visa processing service, we will have your passport for at least 4 weeks. Any passports and visa applications that require an express service, or that are received in our office less than 6 weeks prior to departure will incur a £50 per passport express fee. Your passport must be valid for 6 months from your date of return from India, and should have at least 2 blank pages for your Indian visa.

In rare cases, you may be required to provide further information or documentation to the Indian embassy and/or be required to attend an interview at the embassy. If this is the case we will notify you as soon as we have been advised.

Vaccinations and Your Health - We recommend that you contact either your local GP or a travel doctor for advice on vaccinations and travel health. www.fitfortravel.nhs.uk is a comprehensive website that you may also find useful.

Land Only

If you are travelling on a land only basis, then you will need to make your own way to the starting hotel in Kochi on Day 2. On Day 11, you will checkout from your Kochi hotel, and continue as per your own arrangements.

Insurance - It is a condition of booking with us that you take out suitable travel insurance. You must provide us with the name of your insurer, policy number and their 24 hour emergency contact number when you book with us or as soon as possible thereafter. Wendy Wu Tours will not be liable for any costs incurred by you due to your failure to take out suitable travel insurance from the date of booking.

What to Expect on Tour

Accommodation - Your accommodation is selected for convenience of location, comfort or character, and can range from a business hotel in one city to a family run guesthouse in a smaller town. In more remote areas, accommodation may be of a lower standard and may not have all western amenities. Hotels are generally rated as local three to four star standard, but please note that there is no international classification system for hotels and differences in facilities and quality do exist between the UK and India. Rest assured that all hotels used by Wendy Wu Tours are regularly inspected by our staff and our partners to ensure that standards meet your needs.

Four and five star hotels are also available on private tours. If you would like to upgrade, please speak to one of our reservation consultants.

Development - Although India is developing, it still lacks international standards of civil infrastructure and therefore tourist facilities. For example, you may see a hole in the road without a warning sign or safety barricade; concepts of personal responsibility are different to those in the UK. Consequently, tourist and public facilities may not uphold the same safety standards as in the UK. However, all of our suppliers meet local safety standards as a minimum. We want you to have an enjoyable holiday so we ask that you take extra care, use your common sense as well as refer to notices and follow advice from your Local Guide.

Traffic in India

Main and inner city roads in India have a reputation for being very congested. For this reason, it may not always be possible to return to your hotel after sightseeing to freshen up before going to the restaurant for dinner. Roads in India have generally been improved over recent years, but traffic and/or weather conditions may extend driving times. Road construction work usually covers an enormous section of road – not just one or two kilometres as you may be used to. For this reason, the timings listed in the sections below are approximations only.

Meals – Some meals are included in our private tours, please see inclusions above. If you would like to travel on a fully inclusive meal basis please speak to Wendy Wu Tours, to arrange this prior to travel. Included meals are designed so that you can experience the local dishes, their individual flavours as well as the different ways they are prepared and cooked throughout India. For meals not included, local guides will be happy to assist with recommendations on where and what to eat in order to fully appreciate this vastly different cuisine.

Tipping - As with most countries, tipping is a way of life in India. For private tours we recommend an amount of US \$5-10 per person per day for tipping to be distributed amongst drivers, restaurants, guides etc. This amount is at your own discretion.

Optional Extras - Prior to departure you may wish to add on some extra touring or evening shows to your itinerary, as you are travelling on a private basis, which means you have flexibility and choice. Please speak to one of our reservation consultants to discuss the optional extras available. Whilst on tour, your local guide may offer you some extra touring or unique experiences. The cost can range in price, so please allow extra money if you feel you may participate in any extra activities.

Personal Expenses- You will need to take some extra money to cover drinks, laundry and souvenirs, plus any additional sightseeing that may be offered to you. Based on the advice of previous customers an approximate amount of £150 per week should be sufficient; however for those that can't resist a bargain, consider allocating a higher amount.

Exchanging Cash - It is highly recommended that when travelling to cities outside of Delhi and other main cities that extra care and attention is paid when exchanging money. US Dollars are easily exchanged throughout India however, other currencies such as British Pounds can generally be exchanged in hotels and airports provided notes are new and undamaged. We suggest exchanging your money before travelling to remote areas and smaller towns, as exchange facilities can be limited. Your National Escort will usually remind you to do this before departure.

After Your Booking

Once you have booked with Wendy Wu Tours, you will receive a confirmation invoice followed by deposit documentation, which includes a visa application form with help sheet. Your final documentation pack will be sent to you approx. 2-3 weeks prior to departure, and will include a travel wallet, badge, lanyard, feedback form, travel guide, along with your final itinerary and international e-tickets.
